FY 2015 Home Improvement Program (HIP)

The Home Improvement Program (HIP) is a grant program that addresses the housing needs of those Native American Families or Individuals who cannot receive this assistance from any other source. HIP Grants can be used for repair and renovation of existing housing or the construction of new units, depending on the need of the applicant. Federally recognized Indian tribes implement the HIP and apply ranking criteria in the selection of eligible families or individuals to receive HIP services.

Complete HIP applications are due to the Washoe Housing Authority Office by

for the 2015 Fiscal Year.

Complete applications will be submitted to the HIP Committee for review and ranking to then be submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) for funding consideration. Please contact the Washoe Housing Authority for details or to obtain an application.
